

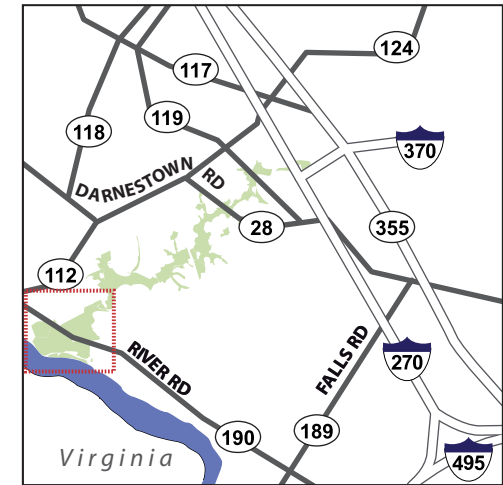


# Blockhouse Point Conservation Park Trails

This approximately 630-acre Park contains a variety of exceptional resources. Natural features include mature upland forest, floodplain forest, palustrine wetlands, streams, river-rock outcrops, at least nine species of threatened, endangered, or watchlist plants, a diversity of wildlife and grand views of the Potomac River and C&O Canal.
